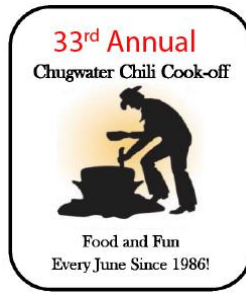

CHILI COOKING:

- **CHILI COOKED ON SITE** – All chili must be cooked from scratch on site the day of the cook-off. All chili must be prepared in the open (no cooking in motor homes, no electricity)
- **ONE RED CHILI PER COOK** – Each head cook is responsible for preparing one pot of chili and for turning in one judging cup from that pot to the judges. No more than one judging sample can be submitted per pot of chili. After a sample of your chili has been submitted for judging, cooks may add beans to their chili to increase number of samples.
- We recommend cooks provide a *minimum* of **3 gallons** of chili for sampling, remember People's Choice!
- **EQUIPMENT** – You will provide your own equipment including tables, cooking materials and cooking fuel.
- Failure to comply with CASI rules will result in disqualification of an individual cook.
- **PERMIT FROM THE STATE HEALTH DEPARTMENT** – Cooks will need to obtain a permit from the State Health Department. They will be on site to issue permits and there is no fee for the permit.
- **COOK'S BAG** – Remember our event with our gift of a cloth bag with the cookoff logo printed on it and filled with appreciation items donated from our sponsors, local businesses, and the Chugwater Chili Cookoff.
- **FRIDAY NIGHT DINNER PROVIDED** – Registered cooks and their parties are welcome to join us for an evening meal the night before the big day.
- **FREE NO HOOK-UPS CAMP SITE PER TEAM** – First come, first serve basis. Spaces are limited so let us know your lodging needs early.

SHOWMANSHIP – RED CHILI:

- Cooks may have one of their team members enter the showmanship team.
- Contestants bring signs identifying their chili team name and booth #. Decorations, props, costumes, battery-powered amplifier, musical instruments, giveaways and your imagination may be used in showmanship.
- Showmanship must be in good taste and is judged on: **THEME, COSTUME, BOOTH SET-UP, ACTION, and AUDIENCE APPEAL.**

SALSA:

- Salsa must be prepared on site.
- Make enough salsa for sampling.
- Provide chips or other tasting option for sampling.
- Salsa Competition Winner is selected by People's Choice

JUNIOR COOKOFF RULES:

- Age – under 18
- First place for Red Chili and First place for Green Chili
- Same guidelines as the adult competition.
